

# Notre Dame University Athletic Quad

## South Bend, Indiana



As part of Notre Dame University’s \$100 million “athletic master plan” the Athletic Quad project will be an ambitious undertaking without parallel in scope or size in Notre Dame history. The project scheduled for completion in spring 2009 includes a lacrosse stadium, a soccer stadium, a track venue and three football practice fields.

The lacrosse stadium, to be named Arlotta Stadium, is a 3,000-seat, lighted stadium with an artificial-turf field, locker rooms, restrooms and concession areas, which will be the competition facility for both the men’s and women’s teams. A new soccer stadium with a total capacity of 6,000 seats and a natural grass field will play a significant role in Irish Soccer’s continued success.

The project also includes constructing two new synthetic and one new natural turf football practice fields adjacent to the new lacrosse stadium. Included in the scope are the demolition and rearrangement of two existing practice fields and the demolition of the existing track.



The final component of this project is the construction of a new “broken back” track containing a natural turf infield to replace the existing track that is being demolished and removed to accommodate the new football practice fields. Working closely with lead architect Ratio of Indianapolis, JBC is the athletic surface consultant responsible for both synthetic and natural grass surfaces.
